Driving Directions

From North/Everett:

- ◆ Take I-5 southbound
- ◆ Take Exit 181 west (WA-524 west)
- ◆ Merge into the right lane
- ◆ Stay in the right lane for 1/4 mile to exit onto 196th
- ◆ Turn right onto 36th Avenue West
- ◆ Turn left at the first light into LCC parking lot

From Downtown Seattle:

- ◆ Take I-5 north for 15 miles
- ◆ Exit 181B (Alderwood Mall)
- ◆ Turn left onto Poplar Way (first light)
- ◆ Drive west over the freeway one block to convention center on the right
