The health care debate took on a new force yesterday, as the White House announced its plan to let patients pick their doctors. Clinton's assertions that the plan would solve the problem of what life before Congress goes home next year.

For its part, the White House staged a rally for 1,100 supporters with First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton declaring that this "is not a Democratic or Republican problem.
